On Thursday, September 11th, Gramercy Park neighbors joined the Police Officers of the 13th Precinct and Emergency Service Truck #1 at a solemn Remembrance Ceremony at the 13th Precinct.

The crowd was welcomed by Deputy Inspector Timothy Beaudette, Commanding Officer of the 13th, and led in prayer by The Reverend Dr. Thomas F. Pike.

D. I. Beaudette thanked Arlene Harrison, President of the Gramercy Park Block Association, and the members of her organization, who led an eight and a half month relief effort in support the officers who were still working at the World Trade Center site.

In recognition of the day, the Block Association had recently worked with the ESU Officers to refurbish the Memorial in front of the Precinct honoring Precinct Officers Moira Smith, Robert Fazio and ESU Brian McDonnell, who died on 9/11/2001.

At 8:46 AM, when the first plane hit the north tower, Beaudette read the names of the 23 Police Officers who died that day.
